The Training Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting an eight (8) hour, POST certified course, BUILDING ENTRY AND SEARCH TACTICS. This course will provide the student with the latest information on building clearing tactics. This course will focus on movement and communication used during structure clearing as well as pre-planning and search and seizure legal issues. This course is for individuals currently in, or preparing to go to, a field assignment. This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.
