## **FIREARMS – TACTICAL HANDGUN ADVANCED**

*POST Plan IV 2310-32065*

The Training and Education Bureau of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is presenting a forty (40) hour, POST certified Advanced TACTICAL HANDGUN Course. ***This course fulfills the Perishable Skills Program (PSP), Category 1, Tactical Firearms requirements.***

Students attending this class will learn practical applications for deploying the handgun in tactical and gun-fight situations. The course topics include shooting on the move drills, one-handed considerations, dim-light considerations, vehicle deployment, different types of reloads using practical exercises and applications. Note this class is physically demanding.

**Prerequisite:** Student must have successfully completed a POST certified academy and currently be employed by a law enforcement agency.

Additionally, SSO students must have successfully completed the office's Tactical Handgun Course.

***\*\*Due to ammunition supply issues outside agency students are required to supply their own ammunition. Ammunition will not be made available for non-SSO students.***

***\*\*SSO students will be charged an additional fee of \$800.00 for ammunition and do not need to bring ammunition to the range.***

***\*\*Cost of tuition and ammunition subject to change.***

Payment is due by the first day of class. Cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks' notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time if the minimum enrollment is not attained.

**Equipment:** Duty handgun and three (3) magazines, 4000 rounds of handgun service ammo, weapon light (optional) and flashlight (mandatory), ballistic vest, note pad, and pen/pencil, clothing suited to strenuous activity as well as being seasonally appropriate, rain gear / cold weather gear (seasonal), ear pro (electronic preferred) / eye pro, baseball style hat recommended, proper belt to support equipment, tools that work on your weapon, weapons lube, water hydrating device, knee and elbow pads (optional), gloves (optional). ***\*\*No shorts or sandals allowed for Firearms Training Classes.***
