Payment is due by the first day of class. Cancellation policy requires a two (2) week notice prior to the class start date. No-shows and those canceling with less than two weeks' notice will be charged the full tuition fee if no replacement student is found. NOTE: Classes may be cancelled at any time

if the minimum enrollment is not attained.

Bring to Class: A pair of Nomex gloves (or similar type) for flashbang deployment. Bring a thumb drive, and

your department's weapons and less lethal devices, if you want to practice with exactly what you are

issued.

**All outside agencies personnel attending this class are required to bring two (2) live Diversionary Devices to be used for safety training and tactical exercises. Students cannot use training fuses or training flashbangs. SSO will NOT supply outside agency personnel with

diversionary devices.

Attire: Students should wear layered clothing appropriate for range duty and weather changes.

**No shorts or sandals allowed for Firearms Training Classes.
